Conference Overview










Making of a Farmer-Centric Cooperative Economic Framework for the Convergence of Development Schemes

This session will focus on designing a farmer-centered cooperative economic framework that aligns with various development schemes. Creating farmer centric Agri-Commodity and horticultural transformation driven by Experts to discuss strategies and to streamline existing schemes around a cooperative model that prioritizes farmers' needs, supports sustainable agricultural practices, and enhances economic resilience in rural areas. 04. Capacity Building to Strengthen Local Governance in Aspirational Blocks and Structural Reforms for Viksit Bharat @2047


